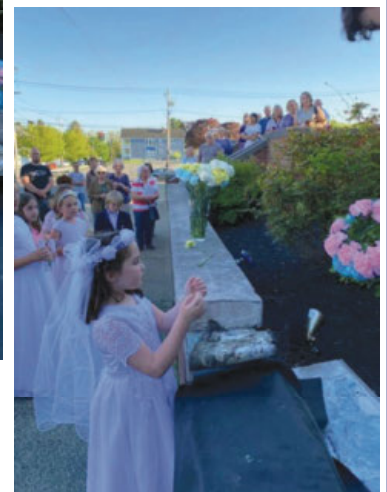
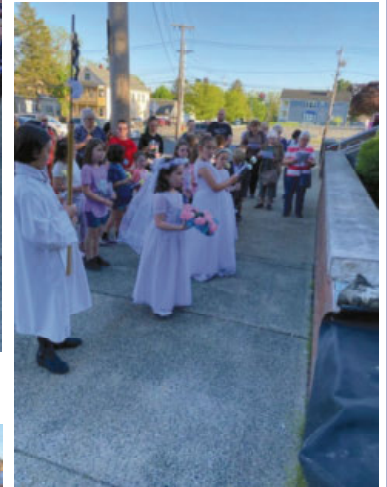
Faith Formation Registration for the 2022-2023 year will open on June 1st.
