

ST. MICHAEL FIRST RESPONDER MEETING: St. Michael is the patron saint of paramedics, firefighters, police





THE FEAST DAY OF SAINT ALPHONSUS LIGUORI IS MONDAY, AUGUST 1ST: St. Liguori is a Bishop and Doctor of the Church. Born near Naples in 1696, he died on August 1, 1787 at age 90. He is the patron saint of arthritis, confessors, and moral theologians. He was the founder of the Redemptorists Order, a congregation of missionary priests and brothers who preach the Word and serve the poor and most abandoned. He was also a composer, musician, poet, author, scholastic philosopher, theologian, and former lawyer. In 1723, he abandoned the legal profession - and with it riches and success - and decided to become a priest. Quotes attributed to St. Liguori include: "True charity consists in doing good to those who do us evil, and in thus winning them over." and "To be silent when we are impelled to utter words injurious to God or to our neighbour, is an act of virtue; but, to be silent in confessing our sins, is the ruin of the soul."
